*15<sup>th</sup> Annual Keeping the Faith Breast Cancer Survivors' Luncheon, a Celebration of Legacy and Living Legends*

*The Keeping the Faith Breast Cancer Survivors' Luncheon is an annual event to celebrate breast cancer survivors and to honor the legacy of those who inspire us. The event is named for Faith Fancher, who was a senior reporter with KTVU TV in Oakland, California. She allowed KTVU to report on her breast cancer fight not to bring attention to herself, but to encourage women to be vigilant, to be tested, and to be brave. As a Table Captain, you are the heartbeat of this celebration. You make it successful and loads of fun!

We have found that the majority of attendees come from Table Captains identifying survivors and supporters; and not mass marketing efforts. Therefore, the luncheon invitation will only be sent to survivors on our mailing list. It will also be available for viewing on the [Breast Cancer Survivors' Luncheon](#) page of our website and can be printed in PDF. Due to technical difficulties, the invitations will not be mailed until September 7<sup>th</sup>.

### Protocol for your reserved table(s) of 8 (tables can be set for up to 10):

1. Tickets will be available starting **September 4<sup>th</sup>** on the [Breast Cancer Survivor's Luncheon](#) page of our website. Guests can purchase tickets using Pay-Pal or their debit/credit card until **October 15<sup>th</sup>**. The ticket types are: \$10 Survivor, \$25 Supporter, and \$15 for children 12 & under. **Survivor Tickets are only available at the \$10 price and children's tickets at the \$15 price until October 6<sup>th</sup>. After the 6<sup>th</sup>, the price is \$25.**
2. Just as last year's ticket, there are two (2) items that need to be completed before the guest can place the ticket in the shopping cart. On the 4<sup>th</sup>, familiarize yourself with the ticket gallery in case your guests have questions.
  - Item #1
    - Enter your name or your guest name(s)
    - **BREAST SURVIVORS ONLY:** Enter number of years survivor (even if you purchase a ticket other than a Survivor Ticket)
    - Enter meal choice
    - Multiple guests' information can be entered for the same ticket type, but enter quantity of tickets purchased at checkout.
  - Item #2
    - Enter Table Captain's name or "none".
    - Guests without a Table Captain will be contacted if Revivals assigns them to a Table Captain's reserved table.
  - If a paid guest cannot attend, notify us ASAP via email. Their amount paid will be considered a donation **UNLESS** you indicate that you have transferred the ticket to someone else **AND** give us the contact information for that guest. If on **October 16<sup>th</sup>** your table does not have 8 people, Revivals will assign guests to your table.
3. Guests can valet or self-park. If they come through the main entrance of the hotel, they will take an immediate left up the escalator to the ballroom.

4. At the event, guests will check in with the volunteers at either the Survivor Center or Supporter Center, as in previous years. They will give their name and receive a meal ticket to place at their table setting and a ticket for door prizes. Their contact information will be updated if necessary.
5. If you [Table Captain] are purchasing multiple tickets, and do not know the name of the guest, indicate "guest" in Item #1. You must provide Revivals with the guest's name and meal choice by **October 16<sup>th</sup>** so that we can draft their meal and door prize ticket; otherwise you will be required to meet your guest(s) in the lobby and escort them to the appropriate check in table (their ticket will be listed under your name and Revivals will make the meal choice. You should stay in the lobby until all your unnamed guests gain entry.)
6. Feel free to contact me if you have questions about your guest list.

This year's celebration is all about music, movement, and humor. We find that these are effective anti-depressants. There will be a mixture of old and new school jams from my playlist. If you have a favorite song, email me the title and artist so I can add it. Guests will be more pumped to hit the dance floor if you are out there. The Open Mic Show features YOU and the Survivors!! Yes, we are having an Open Mic Show!! Survivors will receive a joke to read. In addition, you and the Survivors will be randomly selected to grace the mic with a funny story or a warm & fuzzy story that ended up encouraging you to thrive another day. I really need your participation to bring the humor, WITH PROPS IF YOU'D LIKE. Sometimes finding the humor is hard for people who are facing breast cancer or grieving the loss of someone due of breast cancer (or loss in general). Survivors are being asked to submit a photo of themselves smiling or laughing in advance of the celebration. These photos will be added to the room decorations.

We are in production of the 2019 Calendar. Survivors not featured have a chance to have their birthday listed. The details are listed on the Invitation. The Battle Born Dollz will be selling the 2019 calendars and 100% of the proceeds will benefit Revivals. The presale will be announced and there will be calendars available at the luncheon. After the luncheon, calendars can be purchased on line. Survivors will be able to sign up to be calendar girls for the 2020 edition.

As you know, I am an essential oil Wellness Advocate for doTERRA International and certified in AromaTouch Technique. Each Invitation contains an offer to book me for an AromaTouch BEFORE the luncheon. This is a good way for survivors to have a personal individual experience. *Have massage table will travel LOL.* I also have access to a massage chair if someone is unable to lie down. Survivor, Geana Parker will host the booth in the Health & Wellness Marketplace again this year.

The Breast Cancer Survivors' Luncheon page on our website has a dropdown menu listing Table Captains. I will grab old photos just to put up the page. You can send me a different jpeg photo if you want. I'd like to add your bio, why you are a Table Captain, or a description of your business if you are a vendor. Of course being a part of our website is optional and NOT a requirement for Table Captains. Help us promote the luncheon using the Social Media tag line is #nvsurvivorskeepthefaitth2018.
